

Recruiting Patients with Rheumatoid Arthritis

Join a Clinical Study investigating RA medications

From stiff, painful and inflamed joints to fatigue and weight loss, the symptoms associated with active rheumatoid arthritis can seriously impact one's quality of life. Movement may become increasingly difficult and simple activities, such as getting dressed, can be a real challenge.

We are currently conducting a research study investigating the comparative safety of investigational and approved RA drugs and are looking for male and female participants who:

- are 50 years of age or older,
- have been diagnosed with moderate to severe rheumatoid arthritis,
- are currently taking methotrexate,
- are not adequately responding to current treatment,
- have at least one of several cardiovascular risk factors, which may include smoking, hypertension and diabetes,
- and are willing to comply with a schedule of medical visits and procedures.

If you are eligible for participation, you will be randomized to receive one of the study medications and all study-related medical care at no cost to you.
